NOTICE PURSUANT TO THE UTILITY ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT OF AN APPLICATION TO A FEDERAL AGENCY BY RENEW DEVELOPMENT HOLDCO LLC TO CONSTRUCT THE MOSEY SOLAR PROJECT, A SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC FACILITY WITH A 230KV GENERATION TIE LINE AND ANCILLARY FACILITIES

#### I. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to the Nevada Utility Environmental Protection Act ("UEPA"), Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") Sections 704.820 to 704.900 and Sections 703.415 to 703.427 of the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"), Renew Development Holdco LLC ("Renew Development") hereby files a Notice with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (the "Commission") that Renew Development is filing, contemporaneous with this Notice, an application with a federal agency to allow it to construct the Mosey Project (the "Project" or "Proposed Project") a 500 megawatt ("MW") photovoltaic ("PV") solar electric generating facility, which will include a 230 kilovolt ("kV") generation tie ("gen tie") line and other ancillary facilities.

The Project falls within the definition of a "utility facility" pursuant to NRS 704.860.1 because it is a renewable energy electric generating facility of 70 MW or greater. Because the Project is located on federal land administered by the Bureau of Land Management ("BLM"), the BLM is required to conduct an environmental analysis of the Project pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA"), 42 U.S.C. §4321. Accordingly, this Notice is being filed

The Project is located on approximately 3,471 acres of BLM-managed land in the Pahrump Valley, approximately 40 miles west of Las Vegas and southeast of the Town of Pahrump in Clark and Nye Counties, Nevada.

4. A general description of the proposed utility facility (NAC 703.421.4).

The Project is an approximately 500MW generating capacity solar photovoltaic facility which will consist of solar arrays and equipment, an operation and maintenance building, an onsite substation/switching station, access roads, and a generation tie (gen-tie") line.
